Evening Volcano Explorer (approx 10 Hrs from Kona)

There is no Big Island tour quite as spectacular as seeing the volcano at night, and nobody takes you to where the action is like KapohoKine Adventures! We will take you to the Puna District on the East-side of the Big Island, home to the best lava viewing locations. Your guide will prepare a Hawaiian-style barbecue dinner at our private macadamia nut and honey farm complete with choice of complimentary beverage including sodas, juice and bottled water. Continue to the heart of the volcano with a scenic drive along the Puna Coast to Kalapana. Walk across the lava to visit the site of the most beautiful black sand beach in the world, Kaimu, entombed since 1990 under 75 feet of lava. Sunset/Stargazing Tour (7-8 Hours)

On the summit, your guide will point out the observatories as they begin to open and rotate into position. Learn about famous observatories such as Keck, Subaru and Gemini. Lots of time for photos while the sunset transforms the area into a beautiful and quite unearthly spectacle. When the best of the color has past, we descend to mid-mountain, where the sky is equally clear but the climate is always much more comfortable for stargazing.

Whenever possible, we explore the night sky using a large portable telescope, taking time to diagram the constellations and to learn some basic astronomy. Our guides are famous for their ability to locate the treasures of the night sky and interpret them in a way that everyone can understand.
